

What is HopeFest?

HopeFest is a back to school event that equips students with the necessary tools to be fully prepared for the first day of school.

How did it start?

New Life Covenant wanted to create an end of summer event catered to the Christian community and organized a concert in Humboldt Park that was called WorshipFest. At this event we gave away 500 book bags to those in attendance.

After the first event, New Life recognized the need in the community and heard the call to action the Lord was directing at our congregation. We understood that while the spiritual need was being addressed through WorshipFest, there was also a tangible need that required our attention. That call to action and vision gave birth to what is now known as HopeFest.

Who do you serve?

Throughout the years we have met people from all across Chicago and the surrounding suburbs.

What happens at HopeFest?
